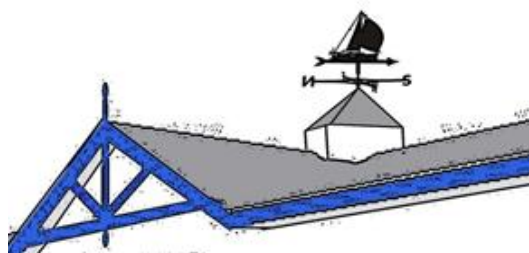
This gives us a great opportunity to create an information and refreshment stand right next to the pier, while creating a trading income for the pier fund.
