We have taken advice from Public Health England as we have had a family contact us, who have recently been advised by a doctor after stating their child may have symptoms of coronavirus.....the doctor suggested 'PROBABLE Case of Corona Virus.'.and recommended they self isolate for 7 days and inform the school and settings that they have attended.

We have been advised to close with immediate effect in order for us to undergo a deep clean.

Kidzone will therefore remain closed on Monday 16th March and aim to re open Tuesday 17th.
