

## Civil Parking Enforcement (CPE)

You may have seen from a [recent press release issued by Suffolk Highways](#), that both in line with the national COVID-19 response and with limited resources, we are prioritising these resources and, with our partners, taking a common-sense view around using Civil Parking Enforcement (CPE) powers at the moment.

This is to support Suffolk's county-wide effort to maintain access for emergency vehicles and key workers.
