Notification of Works to Trees Protected by a Preservation Order - T1 and T2 (Scots Pine) - Fell

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Babergh District Council as Local Planning Authority, hereby give notice that **CONSENT HAS BEEN GRANTED** to carry out the works described above affecting tree(s) protected by Tree Preservation Order in accordance with details submitted as part of the application for consent, subject to the following conditions:

1. QUALITY CONTROL OF WORKS

That all works permitted by this decision take place and are entirely carried out in accordance with guidance set out in the British Standards publication BS 3998: Recommendations for Tree Work.

Reason - In the interests of good arboriculture and avoidance of detrimental impact on the tree/s.

2. REPLACEMENT TREE PLANTING

Unless otherwise agreed, no works to any tree(s) shall be carried out until the Council has approved full written details of every tree to be planted by way of a replacement for any felled under the terms of this consent. This information shall include proposed location, species, size at the date of planting, and the approximate date of planting.

Reason: To ensure continuing amenity and tree cover within the local area.

3. ACTION REQUIRED IN ACCORDANCE WITH A SPECIFIC TIMETABLE:  
COMMENCEMENT TIME LIMIT

The work authorised by this Notice must be completed within two years of the date of this Notice. If the work is not completed within this period, for whatever reason, authority to proceed will expire and a further application must be submitted.

**Notes to Applicant:**

The Council advises that where works are proposed to trees not under the direct ownership of the applicant, permission should be sought from the owner prior to works commencing.
